With Spring fast approaching, the time is right to bring you up to date on a number of issues of interest to the community here at Deepcut Station.

Many of you may be aware that there is a great deal of work under way that will significantly affect the future of Deepcut. Under the Project title of WELLESLEY, a very large change programme will see the development and build of a new, state-of-theart College at Worthy Down, near Winchester.

# Welcome from the Commandant Brigadier A B McLeod, Commandant DCLPA

This will house a number of elements of the Defence College of Logistics and Personnel Administration (which, from 01 April 2013 will be re-named the Defence College of Logistics, Policing and Administration (DCLPA)).

Project WELLESLEY will include the move from, and closure of, Deepcut by the end of 2018. The Princess Royal Barracks will be disposed of via the **Defence Infrastructure Organisation** (DIO), and Surrey Heath Borough Council has submitted planning applications to develop the site into housing. In time, there will be an additional 1200 new-build houses on the former barracks site, with additional shops and open park areas.

The current Married Quarters patches and the Community Centre will be retained, and will continue to serve Pirbright and other local units. My staff are engaged in a number of areas to ensure that the needs of the military community – now and in the future - are understood and catered for. We will pass on detail as things



YOUR CAR When leaving your vehicle parked and unattended ensure that you remove a aluable items and lock the car; if you have a garage secure your vehicle in the garage.

YOUR SAT NAV Review routes set into any satellite navigation devices you own; remov your home address from your list of favourites or consider renaming it so it is not obvious to potential offenders; in the event that your sat nav is stolen at a location away from your home address, this might indicate to criminals that your property is unoccupied.

YOUR SOCIAL MEDIA Consider what you post on any Social Media you use; don't advertise if you are going away and make your home vulnerable to attack. Service Families be particularly careful not to post sensitive information in relation to deployments

YOUR PROPERTY Keep all vehicle keys out of sight and reach of windows and doors. Ensure that external doors and ground floor windows are double locked and keys remove Trom locks at night or when you leave home. Consider purchasing a simple timer device that you can plug into a lamp, radio or TV simulator to give the impression that your home is occupied when you are away at work or on holiday. Ask a trusted neighbour to draw curtains/collect mail from door mats. Mark your properly and register at <u>www.immobilise.com</u>

YOUR RESPONSIBILITY Never be concerned that you are wasting time by reporting suspicious activity. Report to 101'n on-emergency number or 999 in the event of an emergency; pass as much information as you can see or hear without compromising your own safety, avoid making assumptions about the identity of any suspicious persons unless you know them personally and can see them committing an offence or acting in a suspicious way. \*NB 101 is only available if you are calling from England and Wales.
